



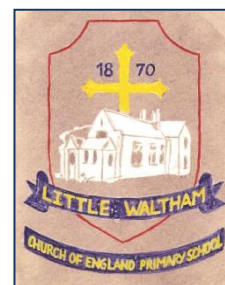

### **Living & Growing**

Following last term's consultations with parents and governors and with due consideration to the range of valuable contributions made, the topic will be covered as an integral part of our Science and PSHE curriculum. Foundation Stage, Year One and Year Two will remain unchanged, but supported by programme 1 in Year Two. Year Three pupils will watch programmes 2 and 3; which cover growth and change and growing up. In Year Four, pupils' studies will be supported by programme 4 about changes. Year Five will watch programme 5 about how babies are made and born. The Year Six curriculum will remain unchanged as pupils will continue to watch programmes 6 and 7 which focus on the changes they face at the onset of puberty.
